Masters in Nursing in Australia is a 1-2 year postgraduate course which is offered in the top universities in Australia. Majority of the top universities for Masters in Nursing in Australia demand a bachelor's degree in nursing or related fields, with a minimum GPA of 4.0 on a 7.0 scale or an overall aggregate of 70-75%.

Depending on the university or college offering Masters in Nursing in Australia, the total program may cost between 40,845-90,000 AUD (22.49-49.54 lakhs INR). International students must also be aware of the scholarships to study in Australia to ease the burden of expenses.

The most common profession after a Masters in Nursing in Australia is Registered Nurses (RNs), which is also a highly in-demand career in Australia. The average salary of a registered nurse in Australia is 75,432 AUD (41.50 lakhs INR)

What is a Masters in Nursing?

Masters in Nursing is a 1-2 year postgraduate degree program which is designed for BSN (Bachelor of Science in Nursing) graduates or RNs (Registered Nurses) to advance their careers. It assists students in narrowing their areas of specialization and further developing their knowledge and skills through practice and theoretical classes. Additionally, this degree program supports students in acquiring the complex clinical decision-making skills necessary to the ever-changing healthcare environment.

Why study Masters in Nursing in Australia?

- The top universities for Masters in Nursing in Australia like the University of Melbourne, University of Sydney, and the university
 of Queensland are among the top 100 universities in the world, as per the QS World Rankings 2022


Masters in Nursing in Australia: Eligibility Criteria
